

## MSAC GRID-O-RAMA SET AUG. 21-22 AT LAIDLEY FIELD ROUNDUP

The lineup has been set for the Mountain State Athletic Conference Grid-o-Rama at Laidley Field the weekend of Aug. 21-22.

Defending Class AAA champion South Charleston and state runner-up George Washington will both compete in the preseason football event on Saturday, Aug. 22. SC plays **Nitro** at 3 p.m. and Woodrow Wilson at 4, and GW meets Hurricane at 6 and Lincoln County at 7. (See entire schedule, Page 2B.)

Each of the MSAC's 16 teams participates in two scrimmages, with each scrimmage lasting two quarters. Limited kicking games will be used. Teams start drives on their own 30-yard-lines.

Riverside appears to have received the double whammy for the event. Not only do the Warriors play Parkersburg - a team they meet during the regular season - but they also get one less day to recover for their opener. Both their grid-o-rama matches are on Saturday, Aug. 22, and Riverside tackles Capital five days later at Laidley in an Aug. 27 opener.

"I don't know why it's like that," said Riverside coach Ralph Hensley. "I really don't know what we're going to do yet."

Capital, meanwhile, gets an extra day to rest up and prepare - it plays two MSAC scrimmages on Friday, Aug. 21. However, both of the Cougars opponents - Cabell Midland and Princeton - are teams they'll meet in the first three weeks of the regular season.
